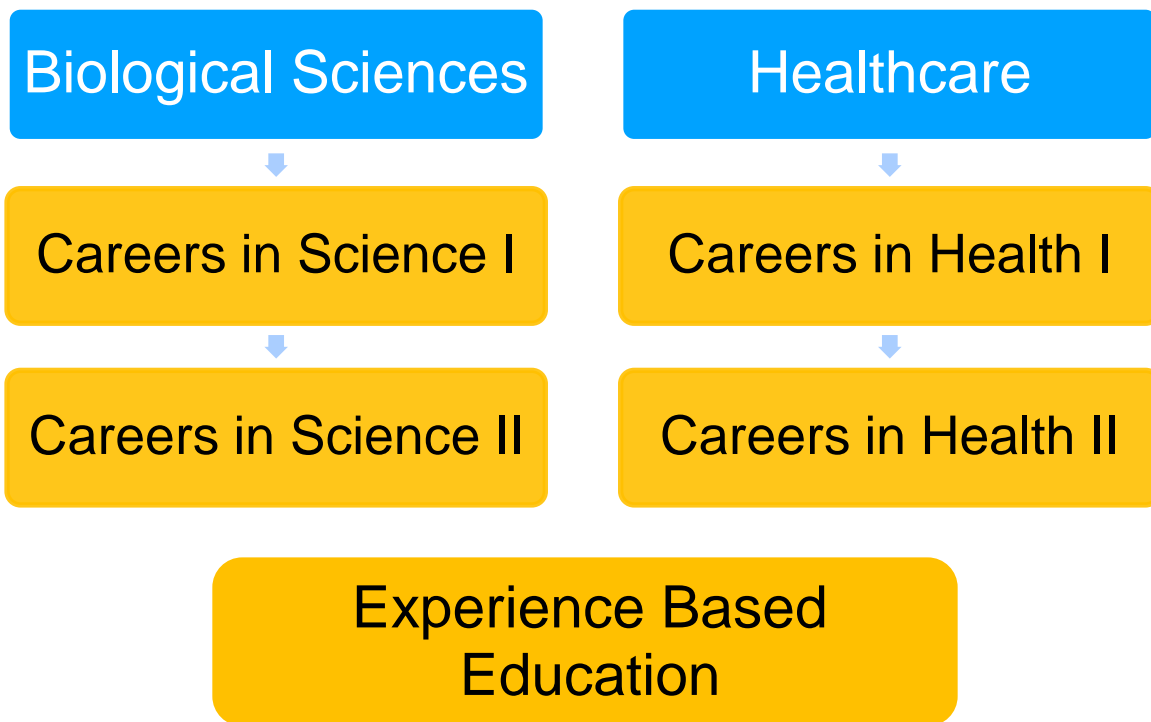


SBC CAREER READINESS COURSES

Be Informed – Be Prepared – Be Competitive



Careers in Science I (BIOL 250) Introduction to a variety of careers in the biological and chemical sciences. Guest speakers will share information including day-to-day activities on the job, educational requirements, career advancement, and necessary interests and abilities. Offered Fall and Spring.

Careers in Science II (BIOL 251) This course will help students prepare for their post-undergraduate future. Topics will include communication, skills identification and marketing, how to find employment or internship opportunities, a review of the application process for graduate education and the role of undergraduate research. Offered Fall only.

Careers in Health I (LS 201) Introduction to various healthcare professions. Guest speakers will cover topics including day-to-day activities on the job, educational requirements, career advancement, and necessary interests and abilities. Offered Fall and Spring.

Careers in Health II (LS 202) Students will gain an understanding of the role and scope of practice of health professionals, patient privacy, professionalism, and a deeper appreciation of what it means to be a patient. This course will prepare students for completing a professional school application. Offered Spring only.

Experience Based Education (BIOL 397) This course will allow students to earn credit for experience gained through educational experiences such as service, shadowing, leadership, employment and study abroad. Offered Fall, Spring, and Summer.
